Position Objective:

Responsible for developing and implementing activities that support business strategies specific to Production and other related areas of influence.

- Responsible to establish improvement targets, measure actual performance and initiate appropriate
 actions in all assigned areas.
- Delegates appropriate authority and responsibilities to Shift Supervisors to coordinate and expedite

 relations.
- By working with the Senior Management Team, conceive, develop, implement and measure goals strategies that meet business objectives.

- Administer and enforce company policies.
